

## IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING POLICY TERMINATION PROVISIONS – WYOMING

This notice summarizes legislative changes that impact your policy.

Wyoming Senate Bill 52 removed an exception for Personal Auto Policies in insurance statute §26-35-201 which effectively changes how we are required to notify you of any policy action pertaining to cancellation (§26-35-202), nonrenewal (§ 26-35-203) and a renewal with less favorable terms (§26-35-204).

We must now provide advanced notice to you as follows:

1. For cancellations:
  - a. At least 10 days' written notice for nonpayment of premium. **This is unchanged.**
  - b. At least 30 days' written notice if notice is mailed during the first 60 days this policy is in effect and this is not a renewal or continuation policy. **This applies to newly written policies only and is unchanged.**
  - c. At least 45 days' written notice for any of the other reasons. **This is increased from 30 days.**
2. For nonrenewals, we must provide at least 45 days' written notice. **This is increased from 30 days.**
3. For renewals with less favorable terms or higher rates, we must provide at least 45 days' written notice. **This is increased from 30 days.**

### How is my policy affected?

Your current Classic Automobile Policy (AC 00 01 04 07) and State Endorsement – Wyoming (AC 001 WY 10 20) do not reflect these updated time periods, and we want you to know that should any of the actions stated above become necessary, you will be provided with the legally required advanced notice of that action.

The State Endorsement – Wyoming (AC 001 WY) is currently being updated to reflect these updates, and you will receive this with your next renewal. We wanted you to be aware of these changes effective 7/1/2025.
