The first paragraph of the Limit Of Liability provision in Part A is replaced by the following.

LIMIT OF LIABILITY

The Limit Of Liability shown in Schedule or in the Declarations for each person for Bodily Injury Liability is our maximum limit of liability for all damages. This, includes all damages for "bodily injury" sustained by one person in any one auto accident for the following:

- a. care;
- b. loss of services; or
- c. death.

Subject to this limit for each person, the limit of liability shown in the Schedule or in the Declarations for each accident for Bodily Injury Liability is the most

we will pay for all damages for "bodily injury" resulting from any one auto accident. The limit of liability shown in the Schedule or in the Declarations for each accident for "Property Damage" is our maximum limit of liability for all "property damage" resulting from any one accident. This is the most we will pay regardless of:

- 1. the number of "Insureds";
- 2. the number of Claims made;
- 3. the number of Vehicles or premiums shown in the Declarations; or
- 4. the number of Vehicles involved in the auto accident.

This endorsement must be attached to an amended declarations when issued after the policy is written.
