

PLEASE READ THIS ENDORSEMENT CAREFULLY AS IT CHANGES YOUR POLICY

SINGLE UNINSURED MOTORIST LIMITS (NON-STACKED) – FLORIDA

Paragraphs A. and B. of the **Limit of Liability** provision in the **PART C – FLORIDA UNINSURED MOTORIST COVERAGE (NON-STACKED)** endorsement are replaced by the following:

LIMIT OF LIABILITY

The limit of liability for **Uninsured Motorist Coverage** stated in the Declarations is our maximum limit of liability for all damages, including damages for care, loss of services, or death, arising out of “bodily injury” resulting from any one accident. If there is no “your covered auto” involved in the accident, then our maximum limit of liability for all damages resulting from that accident will be the highest limit of liability shown in the Declarations for this coverage applicable to any one “your covered auto”. This is the most we will pay regardless of the number of:

1. “Insureds”;
2. Claims made;
3. Vehicles or premiums shown in the Declarations; or
4. Vehicles involved in the accident.

All other policy provisions apply.
